On Feb. 12, 2018, President Trump released his Fiscal Year 2019 budget request that will cover the period of Oct. 1, 2018, through Sept. 30, 2019. Drastic cuts in federal cultural preservation programs were in his request, including reducing the Tribal line item of the Historic Preservation Fund from \$10.49 million to \$5.74 million and eliminating NAGPRA Grants, the IMLS, NEA, and NEH. NV Energy Scholarship Deadline Extended to Feb. 19


