



Historical Nevada Collections - Digital Copies of original manuscripts, photos, and records

Note: each collection is searchable; be sure to use terms "indian" "native american" "paiute" "shoshone" and "washo indian"......because they generate different results. Some will require specific names. And, of course, many have nothing. sdc

Historical Nevada Collections:

- Adjutant General of Nevada Reports 1865 1931
 - Reports contain muster rolls of all men enlisted in Nevada Militia and Nevada National Guard from 1864 to 1930. Also includes updates on military actions and correspondences and an accounting of funds, arms, ammunition and supplies.
- First Constitutional Convention 1863

Minutes of the first Nevada Constitutional Convention which took place from November 3, 1863 - December 12, 1863

- Indigent Insane & Hospital for Mental Disease 1871 1931
 - Biennial Reports including lists of names of those admitted for care, treatment methods used, farm industry production, status of physical infrastructure. and other assorted topics.
- Nevada Historical Society Quarterly

Newsletters from 1957 to 2009 which contain scholarly articles about Nevada History and other general interest topics.

- Nevada Mining Reports 1893 1931
 - Includes Biennial Reports of the Inspector of Mines 1909 to 1930, Virginia City School of Mines reports, 1893 State Mining Laboratory Report 1893, 1921 Ore Samplers report and 1929 Bulletin from the Mackay School of Mines.
- Nevada Orphanages & Reformatories 1871 1930

Reports made to the legislature by the Nevada State Orphanage, Florence Crittenton Mission and the Nevada School of Industry. The Name, age, and nativity of children in the orphanage are listed.

Nevada State Land Patents

Transfer of land ownership from the State of Nevada to individuals from 1865 to 2013 is recorded in these land patents. Information includes when ownership was transferred, name of the buyer, a legal description of the land, date of sale, and any easements.

• Nevada State Prison & State Police Reports 1866 - 1931

Reports by the State Prison Warden include details of prison industries and names of prisoners admitted, released, and pardoned. Reports from the State Police are also included.

Nevada Territorial Auditor

A collection of records of the Nevada Territorial Auditor including a journal containing various financial transactions and a Warrant Register

Nevada Territorial Governor James Warren Nye

A Collection of records from the only Governor of the Nevada Territory, James W. Nye spanning 1861 - 1864.

• Nevada Territorial Secretary Orion Clemens

A letterbook containing correspondence from 1861 - 1864

Nevada Territorial Supreme Court Cases

Records of the Territorial Supreme Court including a minute book, index, and original case files documenting actions and decisions of suits. The records and judgments volume begins with a list of attorneys authorized to practice law in the territory.

Nevada Territorial Treasurer John H. Kinkead

A collection containing a Cashbook, Journal, and Annual Report of the Nevada Territorial Treasurer

Nevada Territory Censuses

A collection of censuses taken within the Nevada Territory between 1861 and 1864

• Nevada Territory Oaths, Bonds and Seals

An indexed collection with the names of all elected and appointed officials of Nevada Territory and its counties. Includes names of Bond guarantors.

Nevada's Sesquicentennial

This collection is designed to commemorate some of the unique sesquicentennial events for future Nevadans and features the times, places and images from the events.

• Sarah Winnemucca

A contemporary collection of primary sources about Sarah Winnemucca - prominent female Native American activist and educator

• Secretary of State Biennial Reports 1866 - 1931

The business transactions and official recording of the State summarized in Biennial Reports of the Secretary of State to the Legislature 1864 to 1931.

• State of Nevada Election Returns 1904 to 1930

Compiled by the Secretary of State, this collection reflects the results for national and statewide elections from 1904 to 1930 as reported to the Legislature.

• State of Nevada Engineer Biennial Reports 1903 - 1931

Reports document the history of water management in Nevada. Proofs of appropriation and beneficial use filings and permits issued are listed for the year 1903 to 1931.

• State of Nevada Governor Messages 1867 to 1931

Inaugural, Biennial and Special Session Messages by the Governor to the Legislature. Includes names of appointees, vetoed bills, finances, and prisoners being pardoned and paroled.

• State of Nevada Mineralogist Reports 1867 - 1879

Comprehensive reports on the State of Nevada's early mining activity and mineral deposits within the nearly 150 mining districts.

• Superintendent of Public Instruction Reports 1866 - 1931

Biennial Reports covering changes in Nevada's education system including the initiation of a State Teacher's Certification. Some reports list names of students who graduated in each county.

• Surveyor General of Nevada Reports 1865 - 1930

Reports detailing the transactions of the State Land Office. The status of various federal land grants are of particular interest in this collection.

Weather & Meteorological Observations 1885 - 1904

Reports on weather conditions and cumulative comparisons of data collected from around Nevada. Later reports also cover crop conditions around the State....
