

April 2 & 9 Treasury and Interior Tribal Consultation Announcement: \$8B Coronavirus Relief Fund

The U.S. Department of the Interior and U.S. The Department of Treasury announced today through a [Dear Tribal Leader Letter](#) from the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs that they will be holding at least two Tribal Leader Consultations to determine how to distribute \$8 billion in funds set aside for tribal governments and tribal entities in the [Coronavirus Relief Fund](#) within [The CARES Act](#).

In addition to attending these Consultations, Tribal Leaders are encouraged to provide their input in writing no later than April 13 by emailing consultation@bia.gov and tribal.consult@treasury.gov

Meditate: Take even 5 minutes to be still and breathe.


Go outside and breath some fresh air. Remember social distancing.

Remember to wash your hands frequently.


