## Open Notice Of Funding Opportunities for Tribes/TDHEs

HUD: Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) Competitive – Applications due 12/1/2021 Under this NOFO, approximately \$95 million in IHBG Competitive Grants are available to eligible Indian tribes and tribally designated housing entities (TDHEs) to carry out affordable housing activities for the benefit of low-income Native American families. In accordance with the FY21 Consolidated Appropriations Act, HUD will prioritize grant applications that will spur housing construction and rehabilitation.

# NEW <u>Tribal HUD-Veteran Assistive Supportive Housing (HUD-VASH)</u> – Applications due 1/18/2022

A second NOFO for the Tribal HUD-VASH Expansion program has been released. This NOFO announces the availability of approximately \$2.2 million for competitive grants to eligible Indian tribes and tribally designated housing entities (TDHEs). Funding is to be used provide housing in addition to other support in collaboration with the Veterans Administration (VA).

# **USDA: Rural eConnectivity Program** - Applications due 2/22/2022

The Rural eConnectivity Program (ReConnect) Program provides loans, grants, and loan/grant combinations to facilitate broadband deployment in rural areas.
