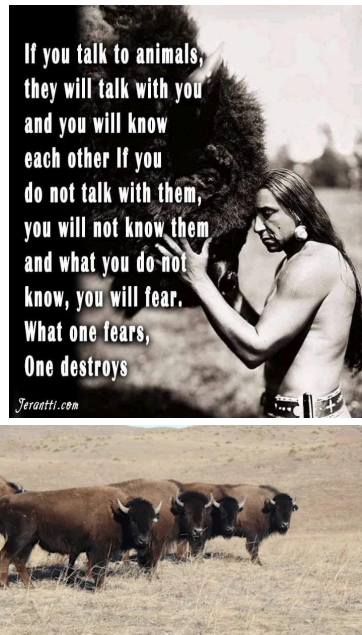

The DPC Self-Assessment serves as one of the foundations of CoSA's State Electronic Records Initiative (SERI). It enables state and territorial archives to benchmark and measure progress in their capabilities to preserve and provide access to long-term and permanent electronic government records.

The 2022 DPCMM Self-Assessment Survey is critical to the work of CoSA's 3-year, IMLS-funded, [BACKER](#) grant through which CoSA is developing and delivering new and expanded technical assistance, educational programming, and training to state and territorial government archives to strengthen their digital records preservation and accessibility capacities.

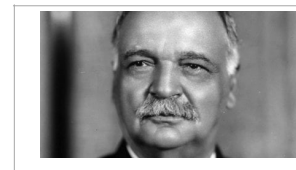

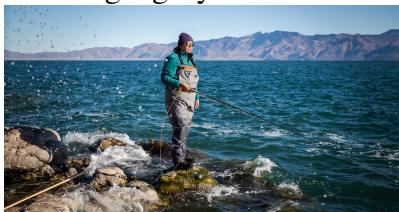

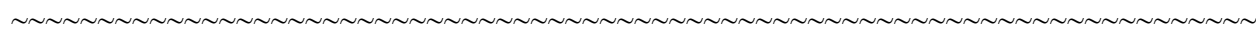
