Compensation will be available for non-federal reviewers!

Individuals interested in serving as application reviewers should expect to dedicate approximately 10-15 hours per application reviewed. Reviewers may choose to request to serve during one review cycle or multiple ones. Non-federal reviewers will receive compensation through GrantSolutions for the time spent reviewing grant applications. Non-federal reviewers assigned to a review panel will receive up to \$200 per application reviewed. It is expected that non-federal reviewers will be assigned no more than 10 applications to review.

All reviewers will be required to sign a conflict-of-interest statement prior to reviewing applications.

The amounts are estimates only and subject to change based on the number and quality of applications received, funding considerations, and agency priorities. Applicants interested in submitting an application for projects benefitting a TIA must identify this in their application.
